Organizing authority

Rules

The event will be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Additional the prescriptions of the Austrian Sailing Federation (OeSV), the standard sailing instructions of the OeSV, the sailing instructions of the UYCAs and this notice of race (NoR). All participants must wear personal flotation devices. If the class rules do not prescribe higher standards, ISO standard 12402-5 (or equivalent) is the minimum requirement for personal flotation devices. The use of inflatable flotation devices (automatic vests) is permitted only if expressly permitted in the applicable class rules.

The anti-doping rules of World Sailing and the Austrian Anti-Doping-Bundesgesetz shall apply. For doping suspended or blocked athletes and caregivers are not admitted to participate in the regatta.

The use of remote-controlled aircrafts (drones) over the racing area by accompanying or supporting persons is - in addition to the legal provisions - only permitted if this has been registered with and approved by the organizing authority.

Appendix T (Arbitration) applies.

Advertising

Boats may be obliged to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizer [DP].

Eligibility

International open for all boats of the Int. Moth Class, registered in the register of yachts in a club affiliated to World Sailing. Boats shall conform to the class rules. Each competitor must hold a third party liability insurance.

Helmsmen shall be members of a club affiliated to their national authority or shall be individual members of their national authority.

Helmsmen are required to possess a sailing license "OeSV Junior-Regattalizenz", a license "Bfa-Binnen issued by the Austrian Federation", a "Bodensee-Schifferpatent" or must possess a sailing license from their national authority (if any). A boat is only eligible if she has completed the registration and signed the disclaimer (liability, images, data).

Entry closing date

There is a minimum of 10 entries at entry closing date (May 13th, 2024). In case there are less than 10 boats the regatta may be canceled.

Late entries may be accepted till the end of registration.

Entry fees

€ 80,– to be transferred to UYCAs (IBAN AT59 3436 3800 0001 9406; BIC RZOOAT2L363) until May 13th, 2024 with the index "Moth Class & Sailnumber & Skipper" or paid till the end of registration in the race office.

Registration

Each competitor shall provide at the registration office a confirmation / written proof of third party liability insurance of € 1.500.000,–, a membership card of their national federation and class organization and a race license (if any provided by the National Authority).

Sailing instructions

Sailing instructions are available at registration.

Courses

There will be standard courses with a target time of 30 minutes. According to the Austrian prescriptions, the time of the first boat must be between 15 and 60 minutes.

Penalty system

Rule 44.1 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

Scoring

12 races with 2 discards are scheduled. If less than 12 races are completed there will be only 1 discard. If less than 7 races are completed there will be no discards. 6 completed races are required to constitute the Austrian Championship. 3 completed races are required to constitute the Upper Austrian Championship.

No more than 5 races will be sailed per day.

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

Amendment of rules 35, A4 and A5: Boats failing to cross the finish line within the given time limit of 20 minutes after the first boat will be scored within this limit according to their positioning at the marks.



Berthing

All boats have to be placed on land at the designated places [DP].

Radio communication

Except in the case of emergency a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data communication that is not available to all boats [DP].

Awards

- 1. The title "Österreichische/r Staatsmeister*in 2024 in der Moth-Klasse" for the best Austrian sailor.
- 2. The title "Oberösterreichische/r Landesverbandsmeister*in 2024 in der Moth-Klasse" for the best sailor being a member of a club affiliated to the OÖSV.
- 3. Material prizes.

Insurance

Each competitor must hold a third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000,— per event, or an equivalent.

Liability, Images, Data: The clauses, that apply to all regattas



General

Competitors commit with their entry and/or participation to follow the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of good seamanship and any other valid rules for this event as well as the regulations of Sailing Federations and the legal standards and participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk in accordance with RRS 3 and accepting the Notice of Race.

The organizing authority, its associates and appointees accept no responsibility for any damage – howsoever caused – ashore and afloat, for example those of crew, material and financial loss, as far as permitted by applicable law. This exclusion of liability applies to the occurrence of damage before, during and after the event, but not (a) in the event of wilful intent or gross negligence, (b) for personal injury in the event of gross negligence, (c) for personal injury if, as an exception, § 6 / 1 / 9 KSchG would apply.

To the same extent, each participant waives his claims for damages against all persons who (a) are responsible for the implementation of the regatta (e.g. race director) or as referee and / or (b) who assist the organizer at his request or order.

The onus of presentation and the burden of proof in terms of the occurrence of damages is incumbent upon the competitors.

The organizing authority excludes liability for lost property or damage caused by third parties as well as unpredictable or unusual damage.

Recordings in sound and vision

By registering and/or participating, all participating persons declare that they agree that pictures and sound recordings of them and their boats/material may be taken and used for media coverage of the event and for their - also future - application, as well as for promoting the purposes of the organizing clubs may be published indefinitely.

Data

By registering and / or participating, all participants declare that they agree that the personal data they provide may be stored, used and passed on to higher-level sports organizations in the context of the organizational implementation of the event.

Minors

Declarations for under-age competitors have to be signed additionally by their legal representative or by a representative, who is authorized in writing for this particular case.

Other

The organisation of the event begins well in advance. Refunds of entry fee and travel expenses will not be provided. In exceptional cases(parts of)the entry fee (amounting to saved expenses) might be refunded -not in cases of force majeure.

Changes of the Notice of Race or other rules (eg sailing instructions) remain reserved, but will be announced in time.

All prizes (especially property and memory prizes) expire, if they are not taken during the prize giving ceremony.

The law of the Republic of Austria applies to questions that are not subject to the autonomy of the sport (association). The place of jurisdiction is the locally and factually competent court for Attersee am Attersee.

Worth knowing for our guests

Registration

The facilities of UYCAs are free available for guests which are registered for a regatta in the UYCAs for three days before and three days after the regatta (trailer and boat). For a longer duration of stay please ask and register in the office (sekretariat@uycas.at), this is only in exceptional cases possible.

If you arrive prior to the event please inform us obligatory that our harbormasters are available with the key for the gate and crane.

Youth accommodation

In the youth accommodation of UYCAs are limited places. Registration is required before closing date for the event. At registration in the office we ask for the payment of € 15,- per night for teenagers (€ 20,- per night for adults) for bedlinen, shower and cleaning.

Camping

For regatta guests arriving by camper, caravan or tent there is a campsite with a limited number of parking spaces in the club as well as sanitary facilities.

The use is only possible after an appointment per E-Mail to sekretariat@uycas.at and is possible only during the regatta or training event. The arrival is possible one day before the event and departure must be till noon after the event. Fee per night and camper, caravan or tent: € 20,–.

Children's playground

A children's playground and a beach volleyball court exists in the UYCAs area.

Adequat clothing

We kindly ask our guests to not visit the restaurant and terrace in swimwear.

Registration fee

If possible please transfer the registration fee till closing date to our bank account. On site we prefer payments with debit card, payments are also possible in cash.

Arrival

The best way to reach the Union-Yacht-Club Attersee is via A1 motorway. Leave A1 at exit "St. Georgen im Attergau". At the end of the motorway's exit turn left to direction "Attersee". Follow the road until you are in the village of Attersee and turn right at the T-crossing in Attersee to direction "Unterach am Attersee". About 1 km later, you reach UYCAs. There is a pedestrian crossing in front of the club.

Site map

In the information E-Mail we'll send you a code for our gates. You can open the gate to the parking area and the "Tor Süd" (situated shore-based on the right side of the street). Through the "Tor Süd" you'll come to the trailer parking area and to the rigging ladder. Please prepare everything there before you move to the berth or to the crane. For an organised flow of the event please park your trailer and car at the provided parking areas.
